

5 Speaking Rules you need to know!

1. Don't study grammar too much

It is important to remember this rule, even though it may seem strange to some ESL students. You should study grammar if you want to pass exams. If you want to be fluent in English then you can try learning English without studying grammar.

You will be confused and slowed down by studying grammar. When creating sentences, you will be more likely to think about the grammar rules than say a sentence naturally. Only a small percentage of English speakers can recall more than 20% of the grammar rules. Many ESL students are better at grammar than native English speakers. This is something I can say with confidence. I am a native English-speaker, have a degree in English Literature and have taught English for over 10 years. Many of my students are more knowledgeable about English grammar than me. Although I know the definition, I have to look it up and use it. Only a handful of my native English-speaking friends know the right answer when I ask them grammar questions. They are fluent and can speak, read, listen and communicate in English. 2. Learn and study the phrases

Many students are learning vocabulary and trying to combine many words to form a sentence. I am amazed at how many words my students can use, but cannot form a sentence. They didn't learn phrases. Children learn words and phrases simultaneously when they are learning a new language. You should also study and learn the phrases.

You might not be able say a single correct sentence if you only know 1000 words. If you only know one phrase, however, you will be able to make hundreds of sentences. You will be amazed at the number of correct sentences that you can say if you know 100 phrases. You will become a good English speaker if you only know 1000 phrases.

This section of the English Speaking Basics is an excellent example of how to make many sentences using a single phrase. Don't waste hours on end learning different words. You will become more fluent in English if you spend that time studying phrases.

Do not translate

Do not translate words from your mother tongue when you are creating an English sentence. You will probably be slow and wrong if you do this. Learn phrases and sentences instead so that you don't need to think about what you say. You should speak automatically.

You will also be trying to apply grammar rules you've learned. Avoid translating and using grammar rules to create English sentences.

It is not enough to just read and listen.

3. Practice speaking what you hear.

The most important elements of any language are listening, reading, and speaking. It is the same for English. Speaking is not the only way to become fluent. Normal for children and babies to first learn how to speak, fluently, before learning how read, then write. Listening, speaking, and reading are the order of natural progression.

First Problem

It's strange that in schools around the world, reading is taught first, followed by writing, listening, and then speaking. It is true that the order is different. However, it is mainly because reading is necessary to learn and understand a new language. Even though the natural sequence is to listen, speak, read, and then write, for ESL students, it is reading, talking, listening, and then writing.

Second Problem

Many people are able to read and listen because they only practice this. Speaking is the key to fluent English. Do not just listen when studying. Practice what you've heard by speaking it out loud. Speak out loud and practice until you can do it effortlessly. You will learn to speak English with ease. Also visit, [Sevenmentor](#) for more related courses.

4. Submerge yourself

The ability to speak another language has nothing to do with your intelligence. Anyone can learn to speak any foreign language. Everyone in the world knows this. Everyone is able to speak at least one foreign language. You can speak at least one language, whether you're intelligent or not.

You can achieve this by always being in the presence of that language. You hear and speak the language of your country constantly. Many people who speak good English are those who attended an English-speaking school. It is not that they studied in an English-speaking school but rather because they were constantly surrounded by English speakers.

Some people study abroad but learn little. Some people who study abroad learn very little because they go to an English-speaking school but find friends from their home country and don't practice English.

It is not necessary to travel to learn English. It is enough to be surrounded by English speakers. This can be done by establishing rules with existing friends to only speak English. 5. Correct material is important.

The phrase "Practice makes Perfect" is a common one that is incorrect. This is not true. What you practice becomes permanent only when you practice it. You will perfect the wrong sentence if you repeat it. It is therefore important to study material that most people use. A second problem that I see is the fact that many students are interested in news. The language is formal, and the content is political. This is not something that is used in everyday

life. This is a more advanced lesson, which should only be studied once you have mastered the basics of English.

It can be both good and bad to study English with someone who does not speak native English. It is important to be aware of both the positives and negatives of talking with a friend who does not speak English natively. You will gain experience by practicing with someone who is not native. You can encourage each other to improve and correct basic mistakes. You might also pick up bad habits if you're not sure what is correct and wrong. Use these practice sessions to review the material that you have studied. It is not to learn to say a phrase.
